Description

The Aston Martin DB7, introduced in 1994, marked a significant turning point for the brand, representing a return to form after a challenging period in the 1980s and early 1990s. The DB7 was designed by Ian Callum and was notable for its elegant styling and modern engineering, which helped to revitalize Aston Martin's image.
